

Entrance Examination's Subject Weightage, Work Experience Weightage and rules:

Total Marks: 250 Marks [200 (Entrance Examination, Multiple Choice Questions) + 50 (Work Experience)]

The examinees should pass the entrance examination separately to add work experience. The entrance exam score is only taken into considerations for scholarship on the basis of score.

Work experience score is only applicable to publish the overall merit list for admission.

1) **The syllabus and Weightage of subjects** in the entrance examination will be as follows:

5) **Work Experience Full marks allocation criteria will be as follows:**

| 2. | Less than 1 years | 5 |
| 3. | More than 1 years and less than 2 years | 10 |
| 4. | More than 2 years and less than 3 years | 20 |

| 6. | More than 4 years and less than 5 years | 40 |
| 7. | More than 5 years | 50 |
